- Day 3:** Delegates observe a rural acupuncture clinic in the Municipality of Poptun or in the Municipality of Dolores.
- Day 4:** Clinic observation in a peri-urban community and Mayan Ceremony.
- Day 5:** Morning review, option of afternoon Assembly of Peten Acupuncturists. Flores hotel stay.
- Day 6:** In Flores & environs w/ optional visit to Tikal Ruins. Eve. Departure to Guate. City
- Day 7:** Departure from Guatemala City.
